# Eildon Kindergarten Report - 4 June 2021

Braveheart's Ditto Show was a great success. The children really enjoyed it and learnt some very important personal safety messages. The program conveys six principles of personal safety; differentiating Yes and No feelings, recognising the bodies warning signs, body ownership, what to do if you feel unsafe, helping children identify language and feelings associated with secrets and reinforcing there is no secret that children cannot tell someone. Ditto taught the children these six principles through songs like 'Run and Tell' (someone you can trust) and 'Private Parts' (they belong to me).

The children also acknowledged 'National Sorry Day' and 'Reconciliation Week', engaging in indigenous art work activities, listening to dreamtime stories, indigenous music and painting a very special aboriginal flag.

We were unable to access the bush due to lock down. Instead we had a couple of our own campfires at Kinder and toasted some yummy marshmallows.

Important reminder: Please keep children at home when unwell, especially during these testing COVID times.
