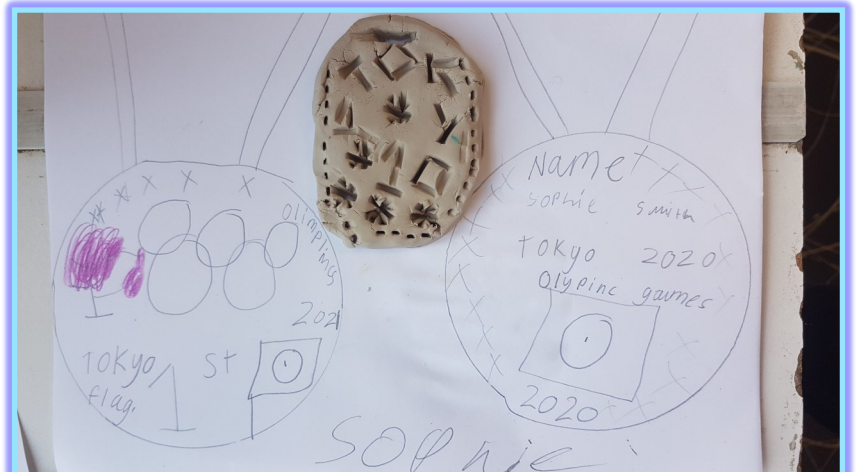
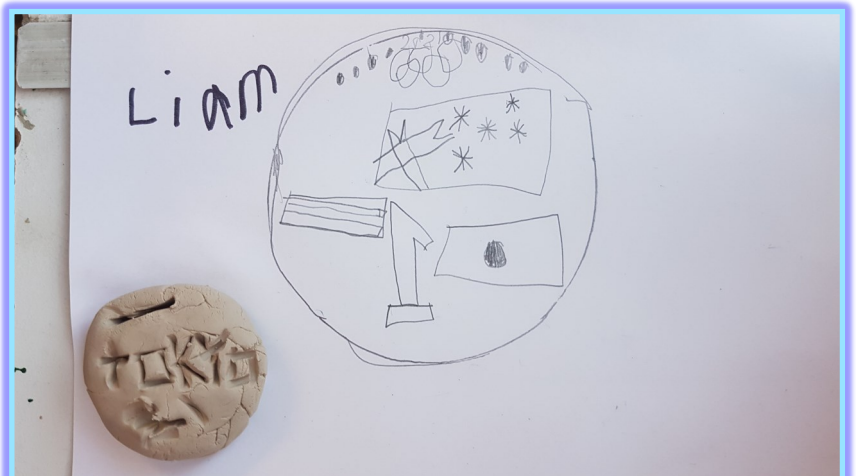
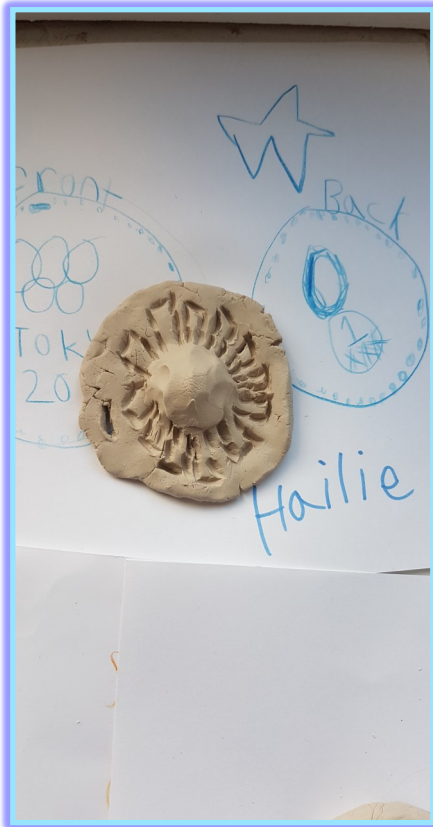
We are currently doing general assessments on the children's development, if you have any concerns or questions, please make a time to discuss with Megan and Kass.
