

# Kindergarten Report - 22nd November, 2019

Last week while on our nature walk/picnic alongside the upper pondage, one of our 4yr old children, Hailie, made a comment about wanting to have her birthday at the tennis courts. As a result, the following Monday on Hailie's birthday we had a blast developing our hand/eye coordination, playing tennis. We were also lucky enough to enjoy some delicious birthday cupcakes for morning tea made by Hailie's mum, Tash.

This fortnight we have also been concentrating on making collage pictures with different shapes, abstract art with primary colours, shelter building with ropes and tarps, cooking apple turnovers, sensory and water play with herbs and citrus fruits (cut, grind, squeeze, smell) which encourages both awareness of senses and extension on vocabulary.

With the 4yr old group, we have also had a focus on numeracy games, practicing letter formation and name tracing.

On Remembrance Day, we had a very important discussion, on the mat, before we sat quietly for one minute, we could hear the bugle call from our Kinder and this led to further discussion and interest on the topic.

Transition Day was a great success for the 4yr old group and the children became familiar with their Foundation setting for next year.

To finish the fortnight we had a few attempts at making the perfect Slime for sensory play, moon sand and also made Sushi, filled with chicken and avocado which most of the children tried and enjoyed!
